Council News

The latest minutes from Leader Town council

June 17, 2025

The regular meeting of Council was held on June 17th with Mayor Aaron Wenzel, Councillors Dustin Heatcoat, Riley Feiffer, Craig Tondevold, Isabelle Blohm and John-Mark Bredeson, and Administrator Erin Romanuik.

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm, the agenda was approved, and the minutes of the May 26 regular meeting, June 2 Transportation meeting and the June 4 Special Meeting of Council were approved as presented.

Council completed their final review and adopted the 2025 Operating and Capital Budget. The mill rate was set at 6.65 mills.

It was moved to partner with the Leader & District Chamber of Commerce to purchase a storage container for seasonal decorations and other items at a price not to exceed \$5,000.00.

The Administrator is to issue a Request for Tender for the tax title property transferred to the Town and an RFT for the Public Works trucks that have been removed from service.

The Town of Leader will sponsor \$500 towards the Leader & District Arts Council's community concert to be held in July.

The Administrator's Report was accepted as presented, the 2024 audited financial statements were approved, capital and general accounts are to be paid and the correspondence was read.

Bylaw No. 02/25 being a bylaw of the Town of Leader to establish a base tax was introduced, given three readings and is hereby adopted.

Mayor Wenzel adjourned the meeting at 9:46pm.

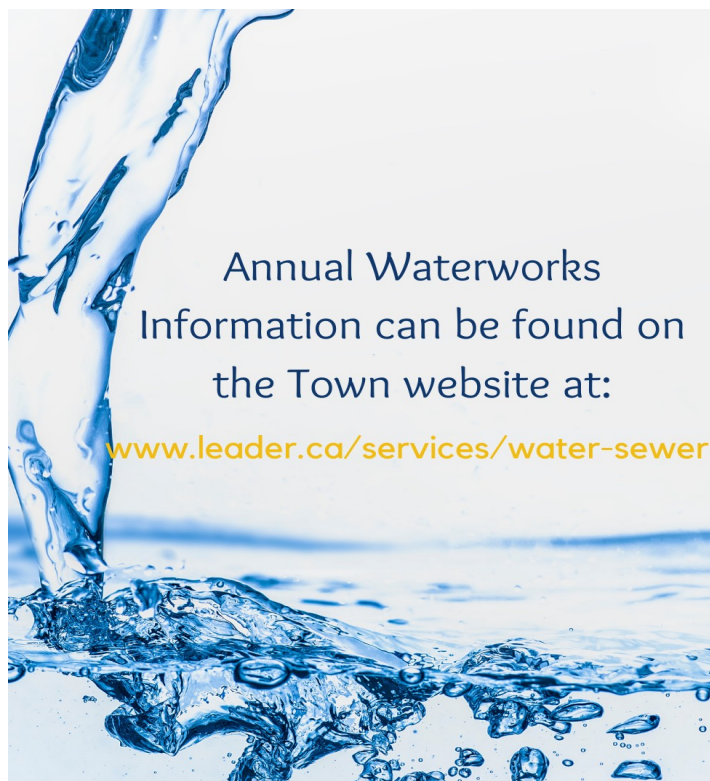

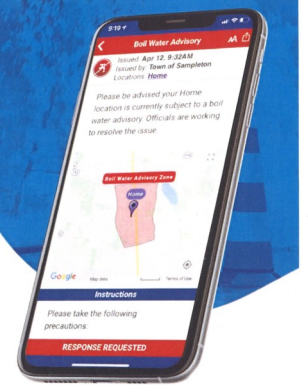
